We had much to discuss in relation to ideas, inspiration, challenges, collaboration and possible ways forward for our respective societies.

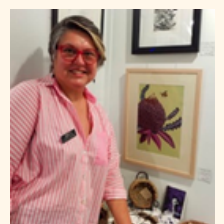


Grants Writing Workshop

TRIBAL WOMAN BUST A Sculpture Workshop with Lex Sorrentino

Using a 2-part Air Dry Clay, sculpt the faces and shoulders over a styrene, wire and foil armature. Kneading clay together will be required. Your sculpture will be attached to a wooden base.

If you prefer, Face Moulds will be available to use.

Use of Paverpol Fabric hardener mixed with Paversand to create hair and garments.

Create trims using Paverpol dipped fabrics and or moulded clay.

Colour with Inks and Paverpol paints.
