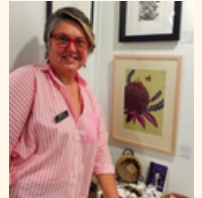

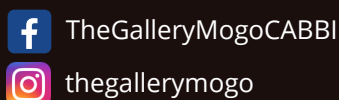

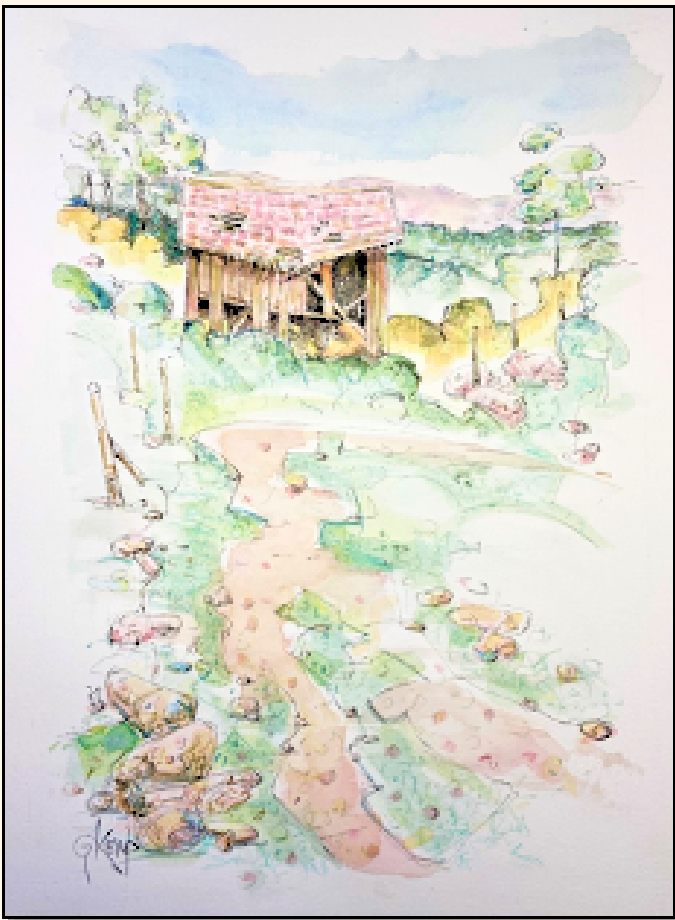

UPDATE - TRIBAL WOMAN BUST Sculpture Workshop with Lex Sorrentino

On the 22 October, our group of artists had a magnificent time with Lex Sorrentino. Using a 2-part Paverpol Air Dry Clay, we sculpted faces and shoulders over a styrene, wire and foil armature. We then worked with Paverpol fabric hardener mixed with Paversand to create hair and garments.

The most commonly repeated statement throughout the day by everyone was, "I can't believe how different they all are!" - every sculpture was brilliant.

Lex was a fantastic instructor and brought out the best in everyone.
