

Our Exhibition planning is on track.

- The date/times and the venue are locked in
- The entry system is up and working
 - The exhibition information meeting at the Botanic Gardens was successful.
 - Entries are rolling in. Note: if you haven't already done so, there is just under a week left to get your entry form submitted
 - Garry Kemp is fine-tuning the administration system of accepting & tracking entries etc (Garry has a note on this elsewhere in this newsletter)
 - There has been a lot of interest in the 9x5 category. Boards are still available at The Gallery, Mogo.
- We are grateful to have secured judges willing to devote their time and expertise. Thank you Karen Warburton and Carleta for your diligent searching and suggestions.
- We have a "grand pooh ba" lined up for opening night, and a musician for light entertainment
- President Lin is successfully progressing the sponsorship program. Despite a difficult economic climate, local businesses are still willing to financially support us
- Camelle Denny is starting to construct the roster program
- Our diligent Treasurer, Carleta Delac, is monitoring the money coming in (and going out!). She will shortly turn her attention to the opening night's catering.
- Furniture preparation is underway



- A \$20,000 renovation/replacement of lights and panels program is also underway
- 35 new light bars have been constructed. A plan to fit LED lighting to all light bars is in the hands of our electrician.
- 10 new panels are being ordered
- 20 new panel "feet" are being constructed
- Closer to late December, I will be broadcasting a call for able-bodied persons to help with the transport and set up of the exhibition furniture.

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40th Year Anniversary CABBI Art & Craft Exhibition

To celebrate this amazing milestone, the CABBI management committee are organising a special Art Exhibition to be held within this years 2025 annual Art & Craft Exhibition.

All members are invited to submit two artworks in the tradition of the 9" x 5" artists of the 1880's. Known as the 9x5 artist, people like Arthur Streeton, Charles Conder and Tom Roberts—would use cigar box lids to create quick impressions of their travels in the Australian bushlands.

Your artworks can be in <u>any</u> medium you choose, <u>any</u> theme or subject matter and in high or low relief. It is completely up to you what you would like to create.

Either in landscape or portrait orientation.

It's all about having fun in making a small works of art to celebrate the 40th Year Anniversary of CABBI art & Craft Exhibition.

The only restriction is the artwork must be in the size of $9'' \times 5''$, or 229×127 mm.

We would love you to consider entering two works into this special category this year



Condition of Entry in the 9x5 Exhibition:

- Free Entry, no fee applies to enter.
- Non Judged Category as it is about having fun to celebrate 40 years of making Art & Craft
- A set price of \$50 on each artwork. If sold, all money will be donated to a local youth charity organisation.
- Two works per member allowed, the panels are already cut and can be collected from the Mogo Gallery.
- Hand your work in at the same time all other works to be submitted.

Another reminder to any member contemplating entering the January CABBI exhibition and has not yet done so:

Closing date is Monday 25th November for Entry Forms.

If electronic submission is not to your liking, you can drop your entry in at The Gallery. If you are having trouble with the entry form, ring Garry Kemp on 04 0488 1080.

If you are contemplating **ONLY** the 9x5 category:

- There is no entry fee and you do not need to submit an entry form and you are not obliged to contribute to the roster duty
- The blank boards available at The Gallery are running out fast. But regardless, you can make your own.

MORE 40th EXHIBITION

ENTRY FORMS INFORMATION

Closing date is Monday Monday 25th November for Entry Forms.

Thank you to all those members who have already handed in their entry forms. We have begun collating all the information from the entry forms and started the next process in organizing your requests.

A few reminders to help those who have yet to submit their forms:

When you submit your entry, please do not photograph your entry with your phone as it is near impossible to get an accurate reading of written information. Either scan it then email to me or drop it off to the Mogo Gallery.

We don't need your labels for the back of artworks given to us. Once you fill this information out, you are to firmly fix them to the back of your paintings, drawings, sculptures – etc. On the morning of handing in your work (Tuesday 31st December, between 9.30 and 11.30 pm), all works must clearly have these labels fixed to the back of each work.

Tax Forms - Your **'Statement by a Supplier'** Form, must be completed with your entry forms. Some entries have missed completing this form.

The feedback and enthusiasm on the small **9 x 5 exhibition** within our 40th year Exhibition has been outstanding. We are very pleased with members responses and are looking forward to seeing the interpretations produced. Please be reminded, these works need not be framed or have a hanging system on the back. There are precut 9x5 panels still available at the Mogo Gallery if you wish to submit an entry or two.


The Roster requests are filling up quickly and we are still looking for some volunteers for jobs on the setup and pack up days. Please consider helping if possible.


I will send each member via an email a message of conformation of your entry. Just to ensure no member is missed in the process of collecting applications.


SATURDAY SOCIAL ART GROUP
