CABBI General Meeting 1st April

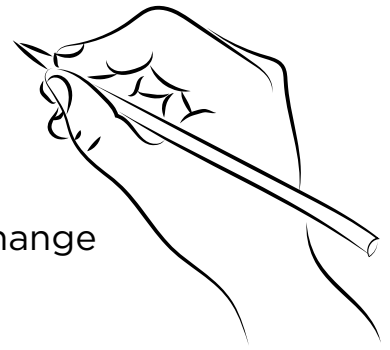

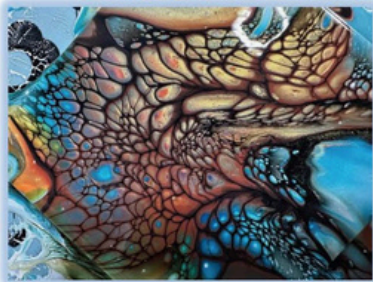
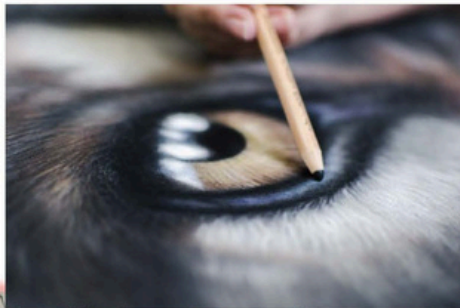
