## President's Report

## Next Changeover: 1pm Sunday June 1

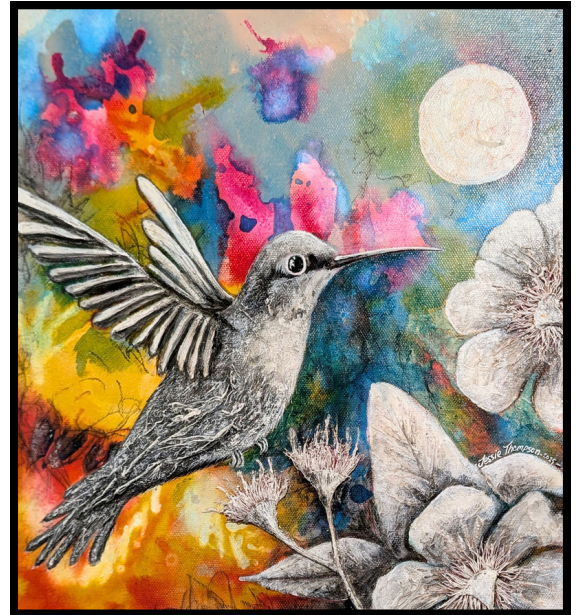
WOW!

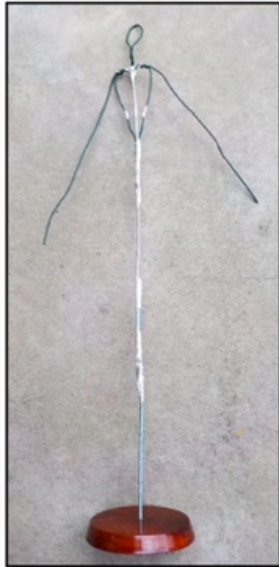

### *Workshop Overview:*

Using Apoxie Sculpt, Paverpol and fabrics you will create a Standing figure similar to the image above. Using a wire armature, foil, fabric strips — you will learn how to create a elegant standing 3 dimensional form with sculptured face and draped fabrics.

Materials you will need to supply yourself include: Aluminium Foil, an apron, fabric scissors, your Favorite fabric for draping, eg T-shirt fabric, including cotton lycra, cotton blend lycra, spandex lycra... but nothing too thick. Woven cottons are okay too, bring them along and we can check them to see if they are okay to use.
