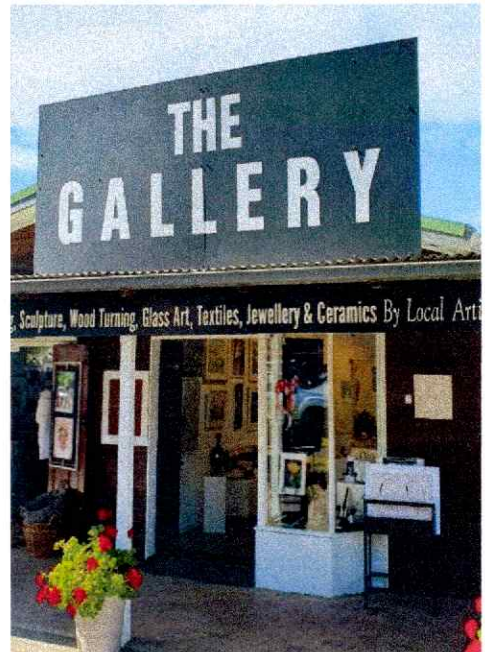

Thank you Garry for your continual support, in making the card stands. A reminder, all cards exhibited in these units must be 75% hand made. (Cards with photos or prints, must be kept on the plinths.)

FRAMING

A big Thank you to those exhibitors who heeded our request for quality framing and the use of glass or upper grade Perspex. It certainly makes a big difference.

(The Gallery Committee is well aware of the use of Perspex in Canberra and other regional Galleries. The Gallery Mogo has never refused high grade Perspex to be used. What we don't encourage is cheap plastics that warp. Due to the fact that upgraded Perspex is often more expensive, and to keep costs minimal, we suggest you seek out a Glass manufacturer and get glass cut to size.)

In future, on changeover, a scrutineer will be present to check on all framing **PRIOR** to hanging. Please have your works checked before you leave the Gallery. Don't just drop the works off and leave. **(Please refer to section 3.4 of The Policy and Procedure Manual,)** so there will be no disappointment when asked to return the work home to bring it up to standard.

HANDMADE AUDIT

There has always been an expectation and policy in regards to **'Handmade'** Art and Crafts being exhibited in The Gallery, Mogo. In previous years it has actually been higher than the **75%** that is currently required in accordance with our Policy and Procedure Manual (August 24) **[refer section 3.3]**

No apology is made from The Gallery Committee when members are asked to remove items that do not meet this standard, or members notified that their work cannot be exhibited. Buying craft supplies online, glueing them to board and framing them, does not constitute 'handmade'.

INCREASE IN GALLERY FEES AND COMMISSION

By now all Exhibitors and CABBI Members alike have been informed in regards to the increase of Gallery Fees and Commission to be paid. Due to the fall in the Economic climate, and increases in our **Rent, Mobile Phone, NBN, Electricity, and water usage**, The Gallery Committee has had to increase the fees and commission to help cover the shortfall. These increases will commence August 1 2025.

CRAFT ARTISANS

All Craft Artisans are reminded to personally audit their own works every 2 - 4 months. Please ensure their works are professionally finished and within Gallery Standards. (when works are removed and wrapped by the Gallery Committee, these works are to be removed from The Gallery, not replaced on the plinth the next time you work at The Gallery.)

All members working at The Gallery are reminded to contact the Artist/Artisan of any **\$50 and above purchases**, so they can restock their works accordingly.

NO Gallery, Membership or Workshop Fees are to be paid at or through The Gallery.

All Members are reminded to use the electronic **INVOICE** system to pay their Gallery Fees, which you receive every month via email.

With every update, these changes are discussed, accepted and minited by the current Gallery and Management Committees. All exhibitors of The Gallery are advised to **update themselves** as to any changes and additions to this Manual. **It is not the responsibility of the Gallery Manager or Gallery Committee to continually remind members of their responsibilities in regard to their continued exhibiting in the Gallery. These 'Procedures' are set to cover all exhibitor and will not be changed to suit personal circumstances.**

No exhibitor is to assume that they are entitled and can make up their own rules to suit themselves. Please be respectful

and give the Gallery Committee a minimum of 1 month notice before leaving The Gallery, and don't assume you can nominate when you return. These standards are set for all. Please show respect and support to all Committee members, for the huge amount of work needed to keep this Gallery functional at a high standard.

INFORMATION REGARDING **LEAVE OF ABSENCE, ARREARS OF GALLERY FEES, ARREARS OF GALLERY DUTY**, will not be included in this Newsletter in future. All this information is covered in the POLICY & PROCEDURE MANUAL.

THE GALLERY COMPUTER IS NO LONGER FOR ANY PERSONAL USE.

If at any time, there is a problem with the computer, DO NOT ATTEMPT TO FIX IT YOURSELF. Please ring myself, Carleta Delac, Gallery Manager immediately.

REMINDER: when wrapping any **resin works**, it must be **wrapped in tissue paper first**, preventing bubble wrap being in contact to the resin. (Bubble wrap directly in contact will damage the resin.)

Workshop Overview:
This workshop is designed for beginners or those interested in painting seascape techniques. Using oil paint mediums, you will be encouraged to explore techniques, methods and concepts of making good seascape compositions.
This workshop will help people improve their skills and enjoyment of making art.
